

PRE-TWINKLE SKILLS/CONCEPTS (BOX VIOLIN)

SUZUKI VIOLIN / VIOLA

FOCUS/KNOWLEDGE

- 1. Focus- ability to make eye contact for 10 seconds and to take a proper bow
- 2. Attention and endurance
- 3. Sidedness violin hand & bow hand.
- 4. Rest/playing feet on foot chart.
- 5. Names of the parts of the violin
- 6. Names of the strings
- Names of the parts of the bow

POSTURE/MOTOR SKILLS

- 8. Steady pulse
- 9. Overall posture- shoulders relaxed, straight back, feet planted into floor, create a table for the instrument
- 10. Master steps to playing position
- 11. Heavy head holding violin
- 12. TAKA-TAKA STOP-STOP rhythm
- 13. Bow hold mastering five finger placement (dowel stick, pencil)
- 14. Soft thumb (jelly fish fingers).
- 15. Bow placement bow arm posture
- 16. Finger number identification (tapping)
- 17. Care of the box

EAR TRAINING

- 1. High/low sounds- recognizing the difference between higher and lower pitches.
- 2. Ability to match pitch with voice
- 3. Intervals recognizing the difference between skips and steps.
- 4. The ability to sing along to twinkle-twinkle little star
